victims/survivors during this time.

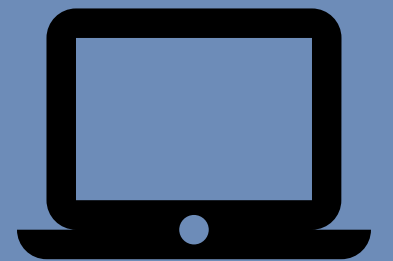
**Due to the COVID-19 outbreak,
